

Guidelines for Non-Original Arts, Crafts and Imports

1. Items that contain commercial components: Any material that is complete, available as a kit, or as an assembly or group of components to be assembled that has a functional or aesthetic use and can be purchased or acquired. A component usually does not require significant alteration to function as intended by the original producer.

2. Items that are commercially processed: Any work process essential to the completion of a finished product done by anyone other than the creator, designer or artist.

Products presented in the souk area or at Munch and Music are not required to be significantly enhanced. That is, contain permanent change of the starting materials.

3. Handcrafted products: Created by a variety of craftspeople or in a production process involving employees or contracted labor.

Acceptable Products:

Imported crafts and goods

Plants, wreaths, or other living materials

Toys, dolls, and puzzles

Rubber stamping creations

T-shirt art

Candles

Body products

Commercial bead jewelry

NOTE: All jewelry will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis by the product review committee.

Music: Music may be played at vendor booth, however, volume must be kept to a level so as not to bother adjacent vendors.
